Kenya: Kakuma Food Assistance Program

Kenya is facing a refugee crisis. Civil conflict in its neighbouring country, South Sudan, has led to an astounding increase of Kenya's vulnerable refugee population. Kakuma Refugee Camp shelters over 174,825 children and their families.
